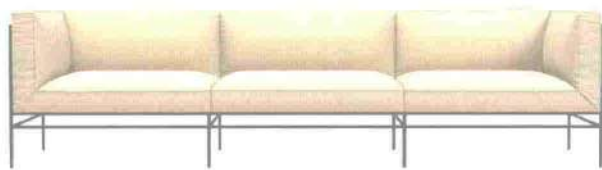




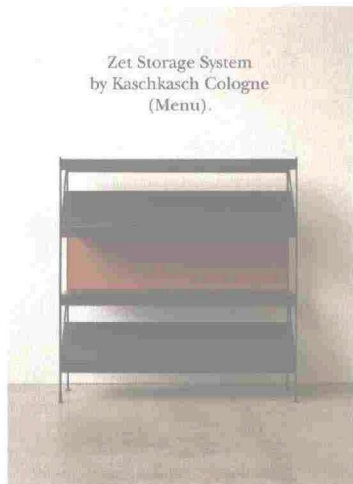
SHARPEN YOUR SENSES

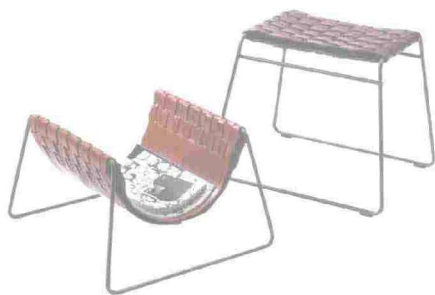
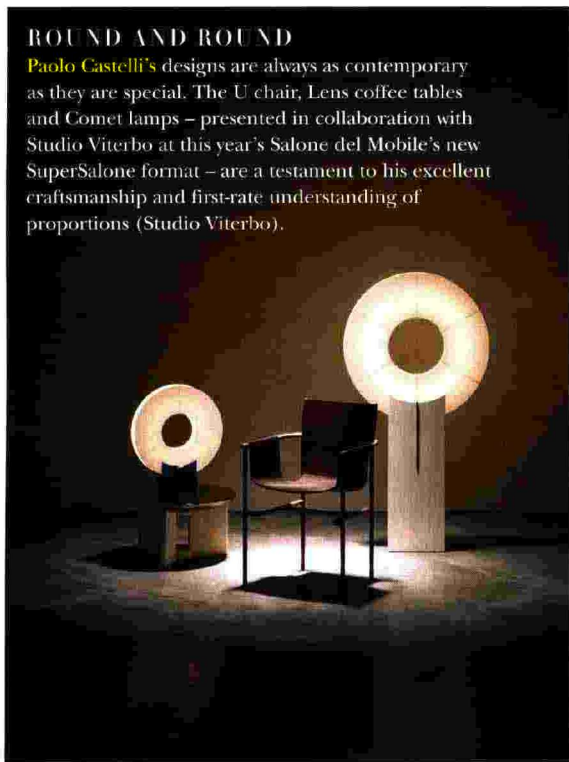
Middleweight sofa by Michael Anastassiades (Karakter).
